Objectives:

3. Teachers from surrounding villages get the opportunity to refer to books.

2. Library is open between 9am to 5.30pm.
3. The person who wants to join the library needs to furnish personal information such as name, residential address etc.

Problems encountered:

2. All interested readers as they have to physically present in the campus.
3. Maintaining all the information about the books present in the library, their authors, the members of library to whom books are issued and all is a complex task to maintain manually.
4. Library does not provide access to computers and high speed internet to readers.
